The public is invited to attend a meeting to hear an update on plans for the new Empire Library. The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 13 at 6 p.m. in the Community Room of the current Empire Library, located at 18 South Abbie St. The Empire Library Community Update will be hosted by Stanislaus County Supervisor Kristin Olsen, Library, and Chief Executive Office staff.

“The new Empire Library will expand access to a wealth of resources, services and technology,” said County Library Director Diane McDonnell. “We are thrilled to be moving this project forward to the construction phase!”

The new library will be located near the intersection of First and I Streets, adjacent to the Regional Water Safety Training Center and Empire Elementary School.
