### **May Events at the Hughson Library**

Community members are invited to kick off the summer season with free programs at the Hughson Library this May, beginning with a number of free crafts for children. On Wednesday, May 6 at 3 p.m. children can make different types of colorful butterflies. Following Story Time on Thursday, May 7, children and their parents are invited to make a big and little handprint of parent and child. On Thursday, May 14 at 12 p.m. children will craft bunnies out of paper plates. At noon on Thursday, May 28, children will learn how to craft a summer garden using dirt and seeds.

Children and their families can enjoy LEGO and game days on Wednesday, May 13 and Tuesday, May 26 at 1 p.m. Children under the age of 4 are welcome to participate but must have direct parental supervision. This program is sponsored by the Friends of the Hughson Library.

Teens and tweens can enjoy crafting with Perler beads on Thursday, May 14 at 3 p.m. Participants can use their imaginations to create colorful beaded designs that will bind together when heat is applied.

Preschoolers can demonstrate their talents at a talent show on Thursday, May 21 at 12 p.m. Participants can show off such skills as counting to twenty, spinning around in a circle 5 times, and singing the ABC's while standing on one foot.

The library will kick off its superhero themed summer with programs for children, tweens and teens on Tuesday, May 19. Teens are invited to the Unmasked Teen Summer Reading Party on May 19 at 3 p.m. Participants will make buttons, edible medals, and superhero bookmarks. On Wednesday, May 20 at 3 p.m. children can take part in a superhero training program in which they can lift weights to demonstrate super strength, make a superhero medal, and create a superhero name. Children will "learn how to fly" on Wednesday, May 27 at 1 p.m. During this program participants will make a cape, learn how to sling a web, and create a power plane. The "Learn to Fly" program is sponsored by the Friends of the Hughson Library.
