## **December Events at the Hughson Library**

The Hughson Library will offer free programs for all ages this December, beginning with a Snowball Count. Community members are invited to visit the library through Thursday, Dec. 17 to estimate the number of "snowballs" in the library's jar for a chance to win a gift card for pizza.

All ages can help decorate the library's tree with paper ornaments through Wednesday, Dec. 23. Each ornament will feature the name of a favorite book, or recently read book, of library customers.

Throughout the month, visitors to the library are invited to drop off the recipes of their favorite food-themed crafts or gifts. The recipes will be included in the Hughson Library Cookbook.

Visitors to the library on Tuesday, Dec. 8 at 3 p.m. can take part in a Snow Day. All ages are invited to enjoy snow related crafts and activities, including a chance to *make* snow.

LEGO play for all ages will be offered Wednesday, Dec. 9 and Tuesday, Dec. 22 at 3 p.m. Finished LEGO creations will be displayed in the library. Children under the age of 4 are welcome to participate, however they must have parental supervision.

The library will host two seasonal crafts this month, beginning with the Elegant Snowflakes Craft on Thursday, Dec. 10 at 3 p.m. Participants will use provided craft materials to make decorative snowflakes that may be taken home. On Dec. 16 at 3 p.m. crafters can hand-decorate glass ornaments at the library. These crafts are open to all ages.

The Hughson Library will celebrate release of the new *Star Wars* movie with crafts and activities for children on Tuesday, Dec. 15 at 3 p.m. Participants will have the opportunity to build their own lightsabers.

Children can Ring in the New Year with Noisemakers on Tuesday, Dec. 29 at 3 p.m. The library will provide the craft materials needed for participants to make their own noisemakers.
