All ages are invited to take part in free programs at the Modesto Library this March, beginning with a celebration of Dr. Seuss' birthday on Friday, March 2 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Children who visit the library's Children's Room throughout the day can search for the Cat's hat to earn a prize, as well as enjoy Seuss-themed crafts and coloring pages.

LEGO[®] Days will be held on Wednesdays at 3:30 p.m. Finished LEGO[®] creations will be placed on display in the library for one week. DUPLO[®] blocks will be available for children under the age of 4, however, they must have direct parental supervision.

Free computer classes will be held this March, beginning with Excel Basics on Tuesday, March 6 at 5 p.m. and Excel Intermediate on Tuesday, March 13 at 5 p.m. Internet Basics will take place on Thursday, March 8 at 1:30 p.m. Computer Basics will be offered on Mondays, March 12 and 26 at 10 a.m. Word Basics will be held on Tuesday, March 20 at 5 p.m., and Word Intermediate will take place on Tuesday, March 27 at 5 p.m. Email Basics will take place on Thursday, March 22 at 1:30 p.m. Email Basics participants will need to create an email account prior to the beginning of the class. Advance registration is required for all computer classes; please call 209-558-7814 to sign up.

All ages can unwind with a Coloring Day on Friday, March 9 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Colored pencils, crayons, and a variety of artistic designs will be available at the Children's Information Desk.

The library's "Saturday Stories and Art" program will be held on Saturday, March 10 from 1 to 2:30 p.m. Following a reading of Lois Ehlert's *Planting a Rainbow*, all ages will paint a flower garden. This program is sponsored in part by the Central California Art Association, and the Mistlin Gallery.
