Modesto Library to offer residential real estate program series

The Modesto Library, in partnership with local realtor Cyndy Hackett, will offer the monthly residential real estate program series entitled "Real Talk Real Estate," the first of which will take place on Wednesday, Sept. 12 at 6 p.m. Prospective home buyers or sellers can gain insight into the real estate market with this free program.

The Sept. 12 program is designed to help guide participants on the path to home buying and selling. Hackett will discuss the current change in the market from a seller's market to a more balanced market. Future topics in the series include a program about escrow on Wednesday, Oct. 10 at 6 p.m., and an investing program on Wednesday, Nov. 26 at 6 p.m.
