## July Events at the Newman Library

The Newman Library will offer free programs for children and adults this July, beginning with a superhero themed craft on Tuesday, July 7 at 3:30 p.m. Children can make and decorate their own superhero masks using provided craft materials. Participants may model their masks after their favorite superheroes, or invent their own designs.

A LEGO program for children will take place on Thursday, July 9 at 3:30 p.m. LEGO play helps children hone fine motor skills while learning to think creatively. LEGO days are sponsored by the Friends of the Newman Library.

Children can make superhero puppets on Saturday, July 25 at 1:30 p.m. Crafters will use paper bags and craft supplies to make their favorite superheroes or create their own unique superhero puppets!

The library will host a Technology Open House on Tuesday, July 28 at 6 p.m. Participants will have the opportunity to receive one-on-one help accessing and using library eResources. Staff will provide instruction on several electronic resources, including eBooks through the 3M Cloud Library, eMagazines through Zinio, digital audiobooks, music, graphic novels, movies and TV shows through Hoopla, and the online language learning software, Mango Languages. It is strongly recommended that participants bring their library cards to this event as access to these electronic resources requires a Stanislaus County Library card.
