Free computer classes offered at the Riverbank Library

Riverbank Library to address community needs by offering instruction on the basics of navigating computers and the Internet

Starting this August, community members interested in improving their computer skills will have an opportunity to do so at the Riverbank Library. Individuals can enroll in free workshops designed to help them learn to navigate computers and the Internet.

Computer Basics classes will be offered on Thursdays, Aug. 9 and Sept. 6 at 10:30 a.m. This class will offer a basic introduction to computers, including an explanation of the parts of a computer, a tour of Microsoft Windows, and simple tasks.

Internet Basics classes will be held on Thursdays, Aug. 23 and Sept. 20 at 10:30 a.m. The workshop will introduce participants to the internet and the World Wide Web, with instruction on how to search on the web.

"We've had many customers request basic computer classes. We think seniors especially would benefit from them," said Victoria Holt, Riverbank Library supervisor. "Verbal bilingual instruction will be available during this class, as needed."
