April Events at the Turlock Library

The Turlock Library will offer a number of free programs for all ages this month, beginning with the celebration of National Poetry month. Library customers may add to the library's "Poet-Tree" during the month of April by writing down their favorite poems on "leaves." Staff members will use the poems to decorate the tree.

Children are invited to a dance party at the library on Wednesday, April 8 at 10:30 a.m. The program will begin with group dances, followed by an opportunity for free style dance. Participants may also visit music themed stations.

Adults are invited to attend "After the firestorm: qualifying for a mortgage in 2015" on Wednesday, April 8 at 7 p.m. California mortgage specialist Jim Liberto from Integrity First Financial Group will discuss what is required to qualify for a home loan in today's market.
