December Events at the Turlock Library

The Turlock Library will offer several free programs this month, including activities the whole family can enjoy, beginning with the "Find the Grinch" program taking place through Dec. 31. Children who find the Grinch in the children's room of the library will win a small prize.

Saturday, Dec. 5 from 1 to 3 p.m. is Family Craft Day at the Turlock Library. Participants can choose from a variety of craft ideas, including snowmen porch blocks, recipe holders, and reindeer message holders.

Local teens can discuss all things books on Saturday, Dec. 5 at 3 p.m. Turlock Teens Talk Books provides teens with the opportunity to discuss their favorite books and find new book recommendations.

The library will host a Snowflake Craft for children on Tuesday, Dec. 8 at 4 p.m. Crafters will create snowflakes out of paper and popsicle sticks. Completed snowflakes can be used to help decorate the children's room of the library, as well as taken home.

In celebration of the upcoming theatrical release of *Star Wars VII: The Force Awakens*, the library will host a Star Wars Day on Tuesday, Dec. 15 at 4 p.m. Children are invited to enjoy crafts and activities inspired by the Star Wars series, including making Yoda ears and Princess Leia hair buns.

Adults are invited to stop by the Turlock Library between 4 and 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 15 to speak with a local certified enrollment agent about Covered California.
