Children and teens can go out of this world with space-themed crafts and activities

The Hughson Library will offer two craft programs in celebration of World Space Week this month.

The celebration will begin with the “Galaxy Quest Activities” program on Tuesday, Oct. 8 from 3 to 5 p.m. Children can make a variety of crafts, including DIY telescopes and anti-gravity bottles. There will also be a collaborative LEGO® solar system building project for participants to enjoy.

On Thursday, Oct. 10 from 3 to 5 p.m. children and teens can build, fly and explore a variety of rockets. The program will feature plastic bottle rockets, footprint rockets, balloon rockets, and a large cardboard rocket.
