Dear Library Cardholder:

Welcome to your library! These are some of the free services offered by the Stanislaus County Library:

- Books, large print books, books on tape/CD, DVDs, magazines and eBooks are available to be checked out.
- Librarians trained to assist you with your information needs or to offer reading suggestions.
- Programs to enhance your use and enjoyment of the library and to encourage reading.
- Magazine articles, car repair manuals, biographies, literary essays, pro/con arguments on social issues and more – available online through the library's subscriptions to premium databases.
 Access them at the library or through the library's web site www.stanislauslibrary.org.
- Access to the library catalog from your home, plus renewal of materials and placing reserves.
- · Access to computers for the Internet and word processing.
- Free wireless Internet access for customers with laptops and other web-enabled devices.

Here are a few important policies you need to know:

Library policy supports the right of each individual to choose for him/herself.

Parents and guardians have the right and responsibility to choose materials for themselves and their children, but the library does not and cannot take the place of a parent or guardian. An individual with a library card may check out any item in the collection, and library staff may not tell children what they can or cannot borrow. We encourage all families to set their own rules and talk about them.

The library is required by California law to respect the privacy of each cardholder. Library records are available only to the cardholder. Individuals may view information in their own library record regarding late charges, fees, holds, and items checked out by accessing the library web site from home or the catalog in the library, using their library card barcode number and phone number.

The library protects everyone's right to know and does not control the content of materials offered through the Internet.

Parents and guardians are responsible for monitoring their children's use of the web. Children's Internet stations are reserved for children ages 4 to 12. Children ages 4 to 7 must have an adult with them at the computer at all times. Children under 13 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when using other Internet stations.

You may use your new library card at all 13 Stanislaus County Library locations and from home. We look forward to seeing you.

Checkout Policies

- You are responsible for all materials checked out on your library card. If your card is lost or stolen, please call us *immediately* at 558-7808 or your local branch to prevent improper use.
- There is a \$1.00 fee to replace a lost card.
- Library cards must be renewed annually. You will receive an email request to
 update your account information 30 days before your card expires. For your
 convenience, renewing your card early will ensure 24-hour access to your
 account, including placing holds and renewing materials.
- Books and other materials can be renewed by phone at 558-7808 or by calling your local branch. Renew online at www.stanislauslibrary.org.
- When you provide an e-mail address, we will send an e-mail reminder a few days before your materials are due.
- As a courtesy, we will notify you by telephone or e-mail if you have overdue materials.
 Upon delivery of the second notice, your account will be billed for the lost item.
- You will be charged for lost/stolen/damaged materials.
- If you accumulate charges of \$5.00 or more, we must suspend your checkout privileges until payment is made.
- If you change your name, mailing address or e-mail address, please notify us by calling 558-7808 or your local branch or e-mail us at cards@scfl.lib.ca.us
