Community members of all ages can enjoy free programs at the Modesto Library this January, beginning with LEGO® Days on Wednesdays at 3:30 p.m. Finished LEGO® creations will be placed on display in the library for one week. DUPLO® blocks will be available for children under the age of 4, however, they must have direct parental supervision.

Advance registration is required for all computer classes; please call 209-558-7814 to sign up.

“Tax Basics” will be offered on Monday, Jan. 8 at 6 p.m. A representative from H&R Block will discuss tax forms, tax credits, and Affordable Care Act tax information. Participants will have an
