Ages 13 and up are invited to explore the Ableton Live 10 + Push, a digital instrument pad, on Tuesday, July 23 at 6 p.m. All experience levels are welcome to explore digital audio creation and original songwriting in this interactive workshop.

Participants will have the opportunity to play live drum sounds, step sequence beats, and make loops as they learn the basics of navigating musical production software. Community members are welcome to bring their in-progress musical projects, or start from scratch.
