All ages are invited to take part in free events at the Hughson Library this April, beginning with a performance by Act!vated Story Theatre on Thursday, April 5 at 1 p.m. The Goza family will perform two multicultural folktales full of physical comedy, music, song, dance, American Sign Language, and audience participation.

Ages 4 to 14 can enjoy the “Plant a Seed, Pull a Weed: Beginning Gardening for Children” program on Tuesday, April 10 at 3 p.m. Participants will learn basic gardening skills while planting starter sunflowers and lettuce.
