July Events at the Modesto Library

All ages are invited to take part in free summer programs at the Modesto Library this July, beginning with the second in a poetry workshop series in partnership with the Modesto-Stanislaus Poetry Center (MoSt) on Saturday, July 1 from 1 to 3 p.m. Local poet Salvatore Salerno will lead a workshop focused on building poems into more durable forms. Each participant should bring four copies of two poems that are currently undergoing revisions. Light refreshments will be provided by the Friends of the Modesto Library.

On Monday, July 3 at 5:30 p.m. children are invited to “paint the night” using science. Participants will add paint to their science experiments in order to make works of art.

All ages are invited to enjoy building and playing with LEGOs on Wednesdays at 3:30 p.m. Finished LEGO creations will be placed on display in the library for one week. Duplo blocks will be available for children under the age of 4, however, they must have direct parental supervision. LEGO play is sponsored by the Friends of the Modesto Library.

Community members can take part in free computer classes this month, beginning with Internet Basics on Thursday, July 6 at 1:30 p.m. Computer Basics will be offered on Mondays, July 10 and 24 at 10 a.m. Word Intermediate will be held on Monday, July 10 at 5 p.m, and Word Basics will take place on Tuesday, July 25 at 5 p.m. Excel Basics will be offered on Tuesday, July 11 at 5 p.m. and Excel Intermediate will be held on Monday, July 24 at 5 p.m. Email Basics will take place on Thursday, July 20 at 1:30 p.m. Email Basics participants will need to create an email account prior to the beginning of the class. Advance registration is required for all computer classes; please contact the Modesto Library Reference Department at 209-558-7814 to sign up.

Children and their families can enjoy the “Didgeridoo Down Under” show on Friday, July 7 at 3 p.m. This Australia-themed show combines music, art, puppetry, comedy and science to promote tolerance and respect for all people and cultures. Children will learn about the wonders of the land “Down Under!” This program is best for ages four and up, however all ages are welcome to enjoy this interactive and educational show.

Children and their families are invited to “Saturday Stories and Art” on Saturday, July 8 at 1 p.m. Following a reading of B.J. Novak’s *The Book With No Pictures*, all ages can make their own word art creations. This program is sponsored by the Friends of the Modesto Library.

Families can enjoy two Picnic and a Movie programs this month, beginning with a showing of Disney’s *Frozen* on Wednesday, July 12 at 11 a.m. On Wednesday, July 19 at 11 a.m. the library will screen the new live-action *Beauty and the Beast* film.
