## **STEAM programs for children to be held at Turlock Library**

*Turlock Library to offer free activities that integrate science, art and fun this August*

Science and art will be featured in events for children at the Turlock Library this August. The STEAM Works events are monthly library programs that promote STEAM\* learning through hands-on activities. (\*Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math)

Each STEAM Works program features a story, followed by exploration of a STEAM topic through a craft or activity. This month's program will be held on Tuesday, Aug. 7 at 4 p.m. Following a reading of Andrea Beaty's *Ada Twist: Scientist*, children can put their senses of smell to the test by guessing different scents in provided jars. STEAM\* Works is designed for children in kindergarten and older.

The library's monthly Art Lab program will be held on Tuesday, Aug. 21 at 4 p.m. The program will offer a basic introduction to printmaking by giving children an opportunity to experiment with mirror images using tempera paint and cardstock paper.

"These programs are a way to not only introduce basic STEAM concepts to kids, but they are also an opportunity to promote books in our nonfiction collection that might otherwise get overlooked. With our Art Lab program, in particular, we want kids to have an opportunity to explore, be creative, and of course, have fun!" said Michelle Coxford, children's librarian.

STEAM Works and the Art Lab feature a different theme each month. All ages are welcome to participate in these programs, however children ages 4 and under must have direct parental supervision.
